Use Science in Context to Find These Answers:

➤ Find Science Experiments involving Insects

Type Insects in the Search Box and click on Experiments immediately above the search box.

➤ Find statistics on Cancer

Type Cancer in the Search Box & click search to the right of the Search Box. In the box on the right side of the page labeled, "On This Page", click on statistics.

➤ Find a photograph of a roller coaster.

In the Search Box, type roller coasters and click on Images to limit your search results to pictures.

➤ Who is Carl Sagan and is he still alive?

Type Carl Sagan into the search box and click on Search.

➤ Are there enough materials to do a report on Global Warming?

After you type global warming in the Search Box, you'll see that there are 90+ reference books, 50+ videos and 3,000+ academic journals.
