


MAKE A MENU CRAFT

SUPPLIES NEEDED: OLD MAGAZINES OR GROCERY FLYERS, SCISSORS, GLUE/ TAPE, PAPER, MARKERS, AND A STAPLER.







- 1. HAVE FUN CUTTING OUT PICTURES OF FAVORITE FOODS OR INTERESTING NEW DISHES. SNIPPING WITH SCISSORS HELPS BUILD HAND EYE COORDINATION AND FINE MOTOR SKILLS.
- 2. GLUE OR TAPE THEM TO PAPER. THIS ALSO HELPS BUILD DEXTERITY.
- 3. LABEL FOODS AND STAPLE THE MENU PAGES TOGETHER. HAVE YOUR CHILD WRITE THE WORDS OR WATCH AS YOU FORM THE LETTERS AND WORDS.
- 4. DISCUSS WHAT A MENU IS AND WHAT TYPES OF FOODS HAVE BEEN GROUPED TOGETHER.

TALKING, WORKING WITH SCISSORS, GLUE AND TAPE, AND SHARING INFORMATION TOGETHER ALL HELP BUILD EARLY LITERACY SKILLS.
