

PLAYING OUR WAY TO LITERACY

Read Write Talk

MONDAY

Write each letter A - Z on a post-it note or small piece of paper. Mix them up and have your child lay them out in order.

TUESDAY

Put a small amount of fingerpaint in a sealed plastic bag and tape it to your window. Have your child draw shapes or letters in the paint with their finger.

WEDNESDAY

Make some noise using items around your house. Talk about the noises different materials make. Introduce them to new words like "shrill".

THURSDAY

Give your toys a bath! Fill a tub with warm water and bubbles. Let your child give their favorite plastic toys a bath.

FRIDAY

Read different books by the same author. Talk to your child about making up stories. Help your child write and illustrate their own short story.

SATURDAY

Ask your child an open-ended question. Try one of these: What makes you happy? If you could go anywhere, where would you go?

SUNDAY

Write your child's name in large bubble letters. Have your child color each letter a different color.

LITERACY TIP:

It's okay if your toddler doesn't sit still for a story. Even though they are moving, they are still listening!
