



PLAYING OUR WAY TO LITERACY

Read Write Talk Sing Play

MONDAY

Pick a story with pictures and try to make up a different story with the same pictures. Encourage your child to participate

TUESDAY

Give your child a paper and let them scribble on it however they want.

WEDNESDAY

Take a nature walk and listen to the birds. Ask your child to guess what birds are making the different calls.

THURSDAY

Clap out the syllables of your name and then help your child do this with their name. (ex. The name Kelsey = two claps)

FRIDAY

Encourage your child to build a city with materials at home (blocks, legos, paper, etc). Ask them to tell you about their city.

SATURDAY

Hand your child some old mail or scrap paper. Tell them to rip it up into tiny pieces and place those pieces in a plastic bottle or other receptacle.

SUNDAY

Draw straight, squiggly, and zigzag lines on a paper – help your child go over those lines with their own marker or pen.

LITERACY TIP:

Encourage your child to use their hands. Fine motor activities such as paper ripping, cutting, or pinching strengthen children's hands for pencil holding.
