- What are some clues that can help me decide if I can trust this information?



Game: Play Reality River in Interland




Book: Read a chapter of one of the Two Truths and a Lie books on Hoopla. Can you spot the fake story?

Let's test your friends by making your own fact or fake test!


Step 1: Check out one of the <u>Weird-But-True</u> <u>ebooks on Hoopla</u> using your library card.
